Research themes proposed:

- 1. Southern European welfare states
- 2. Family policies (elderly care / Long-term Care; child care)
- 3. Health care
- 4. Inequalities in the access to welfare state provision and the capacity of the welfare state to reduce social inequalities
- 5. Occupational welfare (the role of companies and trade unions in the direct provision of social protection)
- 6. Fiscal welfare (the role of tax expenditures on welfare provision)
- 7. Religion and the welfare state (at the individual, organisational and political level)
- 8. Radical-right, populism and the welfare state
- 9. the role of employers and employer associations in the welfare state
- 10. the functioning of welfare state services (healthcare, education, family care, etc.) as a labour market, looking at the type of jobs and the working conditions offered, as well as the working of industrial relations in these services (from doctors and nurses in health care to teachers and carers).
